

Website Terms of Use

1 Introduction

1.1 www.gdst.net/portsmouthhigh (the Site) is operated by The Girls' Day School Trust operating as Portsmouth High School (we and us).

1.2 Use of the Site is on the terms contained in this document (Terms of Use). If you do not agree to these Terms of Use, stop using the Site immediately. By accessing and using this Site you are indicating your acceptance to be bound by these Terms of Use. They are a legal agreement between you and us and can only be amended with our consent.
