Trip: Y7 Latin play competition

Date of trip: Friday 2 March

Purpose of trip: Portsmouth High School pupils have been invited to compete in the beginners' Latin section of the Southampton Classical Association's Latin and Greek reading competition, which takes the form of a short play in Latin.
