After the launch of the fantastic GDST 'Our Spirit' film, Portsmouth High Prep School are pleased to announce that we are joining a GDST-wide challenge set by our sister school in Croydon. The aim is to bring GDST schools throughout the country together, taking part in one huge Sport Relief fundraising activity.

The idea is that every pupil will run/walk at least a mile in their PE lesson during the Sports Relief week of the 17 -23 March. Staff and parents will also be given the opportunity to take part. The total mileage covered by our pupils will be added together with the other GDST schools, in a bid to reach 25,000 miles so we can claim that GDST girls 'run the World!' (For those who are interested, the circumference of the Earth measured at the equator is 24,901.461 miles – but we will round up!) The actual route we are working to is on the map below.



To raise money for this amazing cause we are asking for a minimum donation of £2 per person (pupil, staff and parent) participating. Form tutors will collect your daughters' contribution towards Sport Relief on Monday 19 March. Girls in year 5 and year 6 will already be donating towards the walk on Friday. They will not need to pay any further money for Sport Relief.
